



Thank you for applying to our Bus Grant Program. The African American Museum of Iowa (AAMI) Bus Grant Program is a grant initiative designed to help schools and formal educational institutions fund transportation costs associated with study trips to the Museum. The grant funds up to \$100 for the Cedar Rapids area institutions and \$130 for institutions outside of Cedar Rapids. Funds may also be applied to Journey to Freedom. Mailed applications must be received by this date. Grants are evaluated by the AAMI staff and are awarded to the educational institution that shows the greatest need.

**Eligibility:** Institutions applying for the grant must not have already been for a study trip during the course of the school year. Only students in grades 3-12 are eligible. The school must also have at least 10% of the students using free or reduced lunch.
