

## Cedar Rapids, IA Weekend on C-SPAN2's Book TV and C-SPAN3's American History TV March 16-17

With the support of our **Mediacom** cable partners, the C-SPAN Cities Tour explores the American story - this weekend taking **Book TV** (on C-SPAN2) and **American History TV** (on C-SPAN3) to **Cedar Rapids**, **Iowa** as we highlight the history and literary life of this city.

• Mayor Bradley Hart's segment will kick off Cedar Rapids Weekend, this Friday, March 15<sup>th</sup>—airing on C-SPAN's *Washington Journal* program between 6am-9am CT. C-SPAN is available in Cedar Rapids on Mediacom channel 97.

**On Saturday, March 16<sup>th</sup>**, all of our **Book TV (C-SPAN2)** non-fiction literary offerings from the city will air together in one block beginning at 11 am CT (on Mediacom channel 87), among the programs...

- See the **Czech and Slovak Collection** at the National Czech and Slovak Museum and Library with library director Dave Muhlena.
- Hear from author LaTanya McQueen, about her book, "And it Begins Like This".
- Discover the **origins of the Qur'an** with Imam Taha Tawil at the Mother Mosque of America.
- Tour Cedar Rapids with author and historian Mark Stoffer Hunter.
- Hear about the **Iowa caucuses** and **politics** from *The Gazette's* (Cedar Rapids) political writer, James Lynch.

**And on Sunday**, **March 17**<sup>th</sup>, all of our history programming from the city will air on **American History TV (C-SPAN3)** beginning at 1 pm CT (on Mediacom channel 88), among the programs...

- Tour the **Grant Wood Studio** where the famous artist painted his most celebrated work, *American Gothic*, with Cedar Rapids Museum of Art's Katherine Kunau.
- Discover the history of the **Mother Mosque of America and the origins of the Qur'an** from Imam Taha Tawil.
- Hear about the **Iowa caucuses** and **politics** from *The Gazette's* (Cedar Rapids) political writer, James Lynch.

- See the "Faces of Freedom: The Czech and Slovak Journey" exhibit at the National Czech and Slovak Museum and Library with curator Stefanie Kohn.
- Visit the **African American Museum of Iowa** with curator Felicite Wolfe as she highlights the "Driven by Hope" exhibit.
- Tour **Cedar Rapids** with author and historian Mark Stoffer Hunter.
- Hear from **Congresswoman Abby Finkenauer (D-IA)** on Iowa's 1st Congressional District.
